# The 2010 Belhaven Best Captains & Secretaries Championship



## CONDITIONS

### GENERAL RULES

The Belhaven Best Captains & Secretaries Championship is open to all SGU affiliated clubs.

Each SGU affiliated Club is invited to put forward their Captain and Secretary (or nominated club official) to compete as a team in one of five Regional Finals.

Entry is limited to the first 200 clubs to register with the SGU by Wednesday 31 March 2010. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

The Championship will be run in accordance with the R&A Rules of Golf and the Club's Local Rules currently in place at the time.

All disputes will be decided by the SGU whose decision will be final.

Belhaven or the SGU will not be held responsible for forms which are lost, damaged in the post or for forms which arrive after the closing date that is set.

Verification of handicap will be required at the Regional Finals and Grand Final.

### QUALIFICATION

To be eligible to enter, a player must:

- a) be of Amateur Status as defined by R&A Rules Limited,
- b) be 18 years or over on the day of the Club's allocated Regional Final,
- c) be a member of a Scottish Golf Union affiliated club,
- d) be in possession of an official CONGU Handicap as allocated by the player's home club,
- e) only represent one Golf Club in the event.

### REGIONAL FINALS

There will be 5 Regional Finals as follows:

East	Arbroath:	Thursday 22 April
Central	Dunblane New:	Thursday 20 May
North	Nairn Dunbar:	Thursday 17 June
South	West Linton:	Tuesday 13 July
West	Cathcart Castle:	Tuesday 17 August

Clubs must nominate on the Entry Form the Regional Final in which they wish to participate. While every effort will be made to accommodate your nominated Regional Final choice no guarantee can be made as entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

A maximum of 40 teams (80 competitors) will take part at each of the Regional Finals.

In the event of a Regional Final being over-subscribed the Club will be transferred to an alternative Regional Final, subject to availability.

The Regional Finals are decided over 18 holes or in the event of inclement weather as many holes as it is possible for all teams to complete.

The format is better ball medal with maximum handicap of 28 and  $\frac{3}{4}$  allowance given.

Information for competitors and the draw for starting times will be sent to the Clubs approximately three weeks prior to the Regional Finals. If your club has not received this information by the Monday of your nominated Regional Final then please contact the SGU Events Department on 01334 466477. The leading EIGHT teams from each of the five Regional Finals will qualify for the Grand Final.

In the event of a tie, leading places and other qualifiers will be decided by a card play-off.

### **GRAND FINAL**

The Grand Final will be held at Murrayshall on Tuesday 21 September 2010.

A total of 40 teams will compete over 18 holes of better ball medal with maximum handicap of 28 and  $\frac{3}{4}$  allowance given.

In the event of a tie, leading places will be decided by a card play-off.

### **SUBSTITUTIONS**

In the event of a Captain or Secretary being unable to compete in the Regional Final or Grand Final for any reason then the Captain may be replaced by the Vice-Captain or fellow Committee Member while the Secretary may be replaced by the Bar Steward or equivalent.
