Conditions of Competition and Entry Form Craigmillar Park (72 Hole) Open Tournament Saturday 10th and Sunday 11th April 2010

An Order of Merit Event
held under the auspices of The Scottish Golf Union

The Annual Competition of the Craigmillar Park Open Tournament will take place over Craigmillar Park Golf Course on Saturday, 10th April and Sunday 11th April 2010.

The competition is open to individual Amateur Golfers (as defined by the Rules of Golf) having a handicap of 2 strokes or less under the Council of National Golf Unions Unified Handicapping System. Entry is limited to a field of 76 players, plus two places reserved for the home club. Should the entries received exceed this number by the entry closing date, there will be a ballot of the highest handicapped players to reduce the field to 76. Previous winners of the Tournament will be exempt from the ballot.

The competition entry form below, or a substitute showing all required details and certification, **must be completed and sent together with the Entry Fee of £30.00**, in order to be received by the club **no later than Friday 12th March 2010**.

No entry will be accepted which is not accompanied by the Entry Fee.

Make cheque payable to **Craigmillar Park Golf Club**.

Competitors will receive a Card entitling them to the privilege of the Course and Clubhouse during practice on the 6th, 7th, 8th April (each all day) and Friday 9th April (morning only), and also advising their official Competition Start Time. **Play commences on the Saturday from 7.00am**. Details of Start Times and playing partners also will be available on the club website from Friday 19th March.

The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the specific rules for Stroke Play Competitions, and in accordance with the Local Rules of Craigmillar Park Golf Club.

Two rounds of 18 holes each will be played on Saturday 10th April. The leading thirty competitors, and those tying for thirtieth place, over the 36 holes will qualify to play a further two rounds on Sunday 11th April. All competitors must be available to play all four rounds. The competitor returning the lowest scratch aggregate over the 72 holes will be the winner of the Trophy.

Prize vouchers to the value of - £500; £300; £200; £150; £115; £95; £75; £65; £55; £45, will be presented to the competitors returning the lowest aggregates.

In the event of a tie for first place there will be a play-off for the Trophy only, over holes designated by the Tournament Committee. Any ties will result in a sharing of the value of the prize vouchers for such places.

All disputes will be decided upon by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final, and which reserves the right to reject any entry, and to alter or amend any of the conditions of play.

Competitors should make their own arrangements for Caddies.

Club rules in respect of dress must be observed in the Clubhouse.

Full catering will be available on the day.
