To be responsible for delivering the Scottish Golf Academy training programme to young players aged between 13 - 18.

- A minimum of 60 hours of coaching in the Academy year (October to October)
- Involvement in the annual talent selection process for new Academy intake
- Participation in Academy development/coaches meetings

- PGA Qualified
- Highly proficient in video analysis and have a knowledge of launch monitor and statistics package
- Experience working with and developing young talented players
- Ability to work as part of a team delivering a pre arranged package with resource material using your own coaching style/technique
- Willingness to attend CPD as part of development

This role will be based out of the St Andrews Links Golf Academy so the successful candidate should be based locally to this venue.

Due to the age of players most of the coaching will be at weekends and evenings due to school commitments so you must be able to be flexible with work timings and days.

**This self-employed position carries a fixed coaching fee (hourly paid with a rate of £45.00 per hour however this is capped at a daily rate which will be discussed at interview), payable on receipt of a quarterly invoice.**
