- 1 Play on Sunday will be confined to the 40 leading competitors and ties for 40th place.
- 2 Each competitor will receive the courtesy of the Course and Clubhouse from Monday 1 September to Friday 5 September 2008 inclusive for 1 practice round.
- 3 The Competition will be stroke play in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Ltd. with the Local Rules approved by the Match Committee.
- 4 In the event of a tie, there will be a three hole play-off over the 1st, 17th and 18th Holes. If the tie is not resolved play will continue over these holes on a sudden death basis.
- 5 Driving Clubs must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds when measured on pendulum testing apparatus approved by R & A Rules Ltd.- see also Appendix , 5a of the Rules of Golf. Penalty for Breach of Condition – Disqualification.
