COMPETITION CONDITIONS

NORTH EAST DISTRICT OPEN AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 2010 Cruden Bay Golf Club Saturday 14th & Sunday 15th August

1 Conditions of Play

- a) The Committee of N.E. District Association of the S.G.U. will be responsible for the organisation of the Championship. Its decisions in all matters pertaining to the Championship will be final.
- b) The Championship will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by R & A Rules Ltd. and the local Rules as approved by the Committee.
- c) The Championship will be played over 72 holes of stroke play. The top 40 players and those tied for fortieth place after 36 holes will qualify for the final 2 rounds.
- d) The winner, who shall hold the Trophy for one year, shall be the competitor who returns the lowest score for 72 holes. In the event of a tie for first place over 72 holes the Championship shall be decided by a hole-by-hole play off which will take place immediately. Other places will be decided by count back.
- e) All players must return their scorecards and failure to do so will result in an automatic ban from District events for two years.

2 Qualifications

To be eligible a player must be:

- a) be male at birth and of amateur status as defined by R & A Rules Ltd.
- b) a member of a recognised Golf Club affiliated to its National Union.
- c) in possession of a handicap not exceeding 4.4 (exact) under the CONGU Unified Handicapping System on the date his entry form is certified by the Secretary of his Home Club.

3 Entry

- a) A player must enter from his Home Club. His entry must be on the official entry form and be certified by the Secretary of his Home Club accompanied by the entry fee of £25.00.
- b) The N.E. District Association reserves the right to restrict the number of entries accepted and to refuse any entry without explanation. In the event of entries being received in excess of the maximum of 72 players with lower handicaps will receive preference. Unsuccessful entries will be placed on a waiting list and may be invited to compete if withdrawals occur. Entry fees will not be refunded, if withdrawal is after the closing date.
- c) Closing date for entries is 26th July 2010.
