## SUTHERLAND CHALICE Open 72 Hole Tournament

Dear Sir,

The **Annual Competition** for **The Sutherland Chalice** will take place over **Dumfries and Galloway Golf Course** on **Saturday 10th July and Sunday 11th July 2010**. The Competition, established in 1971, has recently been extended from 36 holes to 72 holes with effect from season 2000 and will count in the Scottish Golf Union Order of Merit

The Competition is open to all Amateur Golfers (as defined by the rules of amateur status) who have a handicap of 4 strokes or less under the Council of National Golf Unions' handicapping scheme.

**Entries**, on the attached form giving the **Name, Address and Handicap** of the Competitor, must be received by the Secretary **no later than Friday 25th June 2010**. The entry must be signed by the competitor and certified by the Secretary of the Club from which the competitor enters. The entry fee is £30 (including lunch voucher) and **no entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Cheques should be made payable to Dumfries and Galloway Golf Club. In the event of entries being excessive the Club reserves the right to reduce the number by a ballot of the highest handicapped players.**

Each Competitor will receive a card entitling him to the courtesy of the course and clubhouse from Monday 5th July to Friday 9th July inclusive for 1 round of practice, and advising him of his starting times in the competition.

The Competition will be played by strokes in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the Special Rules for Stroke Play Competitions, and in accordance with the Local Rules of the Club.

Two rounds of 18 holes each will be played on Saturday, 10th July, and the first 40 competitors and those tying for 40th place over the 36 holes will qualify to play a further two rounds on Sunday, 11th July. All competitors must be available to play all four rounds. The competitor returning the lowest scratch aggregate over the 72 holes will be the winner of the trophy. The principal trophy will be retained by Dumfries and Galloway Golf Club.

Prize vouchers will be presented to the competitors who return the lowest scratch aggregates as follows:

In the event of a tie for first place those players tying will play-off by sudden death immediately after the last players have completed play over holes designated by the Tournament Committee. All ties will result in a share of the value of the prize vouchers concerned. The prize presentation will be held immediately on completion of the Competition and all prizewinners are expected to attend.

All disputes will be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final, and power is reserved to reject any entry, and to alter or amend the conditions. (R. & A. Rules of Golf apply).

Club rules in respect of dress must be observed in the Clubhouse.
