## Conditions

### 1. Counting Events

The events on the schedule overleaf will count towards the 2018 Scottish Golf Seniors Order of Merit.

Events fall into three categories: Category 1, Category 2 and Category 3

#### Category 3 | Individual/Independent:

Seniors Match Play Championship

#### Category 2 | Key Events:

South of Scotland Seniors

### 2. Qualification

To be eligible for inclusion in Scottish Golf Seniors Order of Merit, a player must:

- Be male at birth and be of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- Be 50 years or over on the first day of the championship.
- Be a subscribed member of the Scottish Seniors Golfing Society.
- Compete in a minimum of four counting events.

### 3. Final Placings

- All points collected by a player will form an aggregate and this total will determine their final placing in the Order of Merit.
- The winner of the Order of Merit will receive the Seniors Order of Merit Trophy.
- In the event of a tie for leading places the trophy will be shared.
