

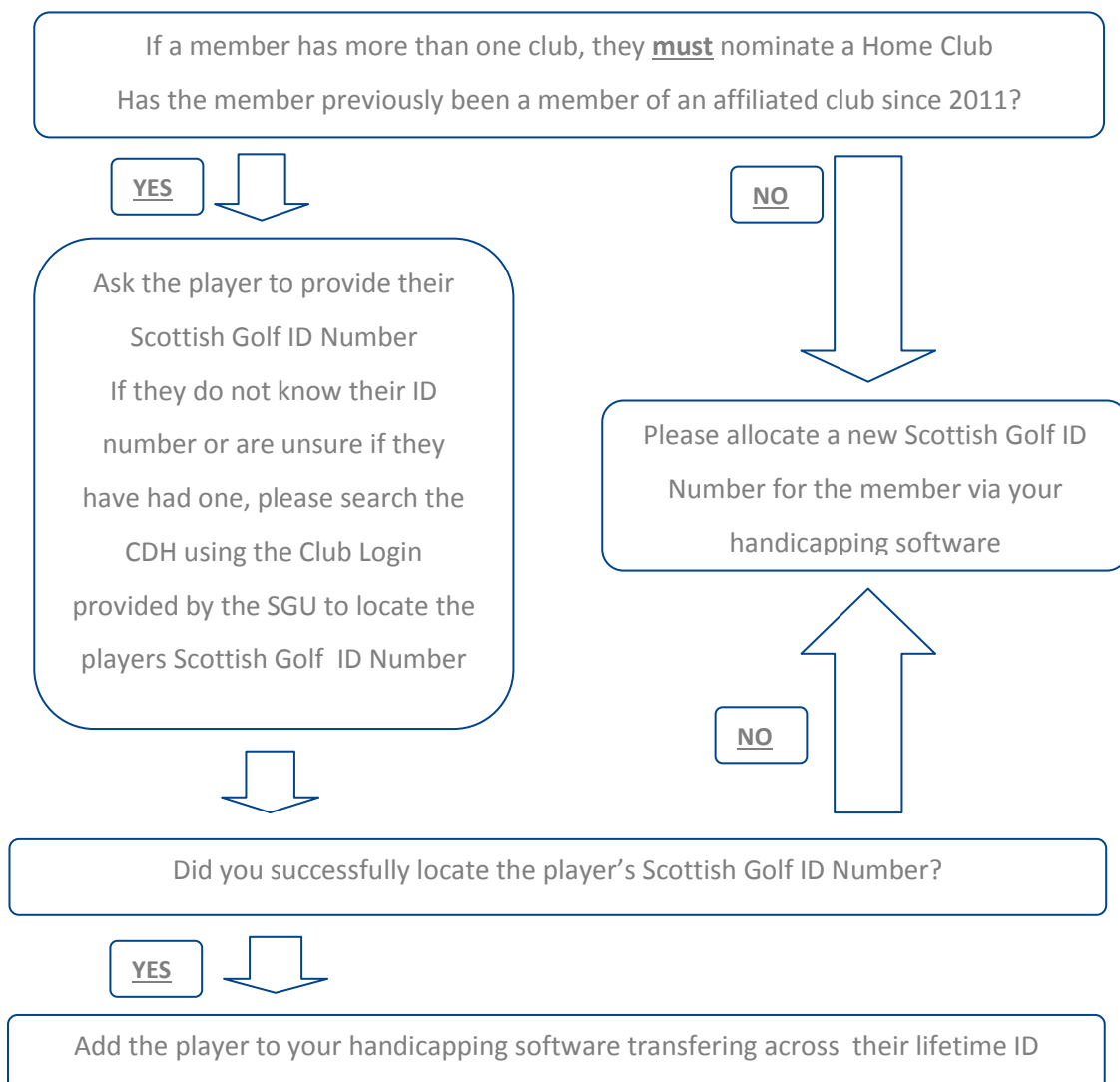

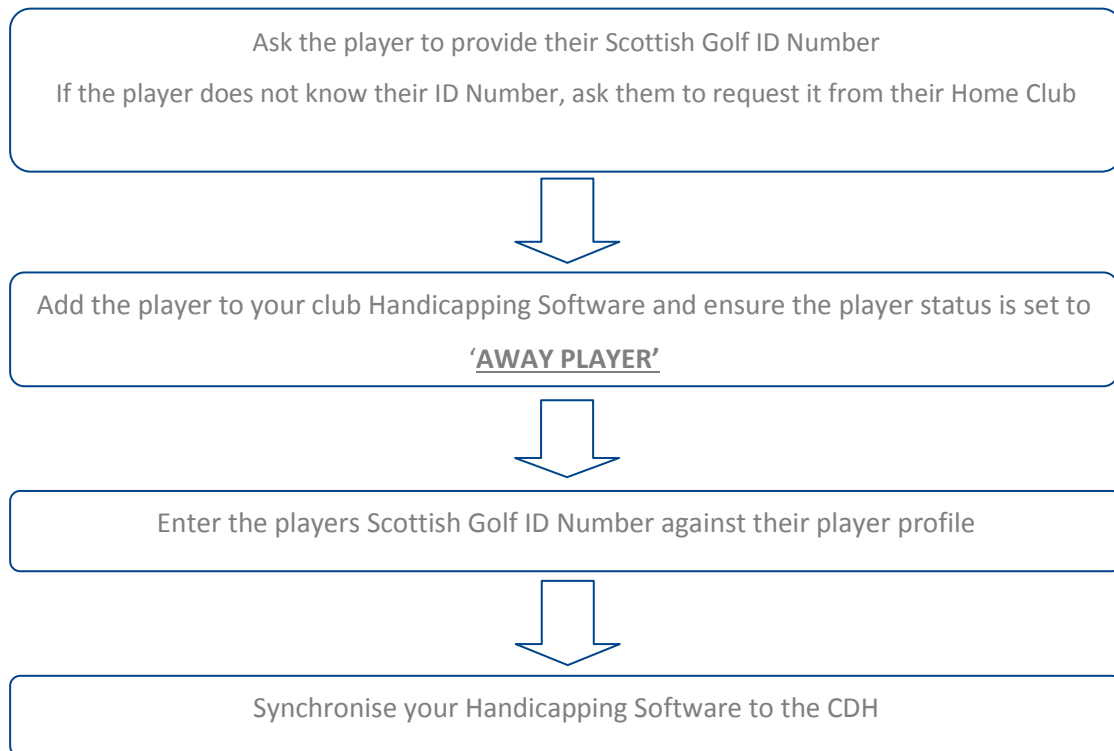
## “ONE Member ONE Scottish Golf ID Number”

- A Scottish Golf ID Number is a unique individual lifetime ID. Each golfer will only have *one* ID that remains with them for their golfing career, applicable at all golf clubs of which they are or become a member.
- When a golfer transfers to a new golf club, their Scottish Golf ID Number is transferred with them, along with their last held handicap and full handicap record.
- A duplicate Scottish Golf ID Number **must not** be created for any golfer
- A new Scottish Golf ID Number must only be allocated by the Home Club if the member has never had one allocated to them previously

### A new member joins your club as a Home Member – what do you do?

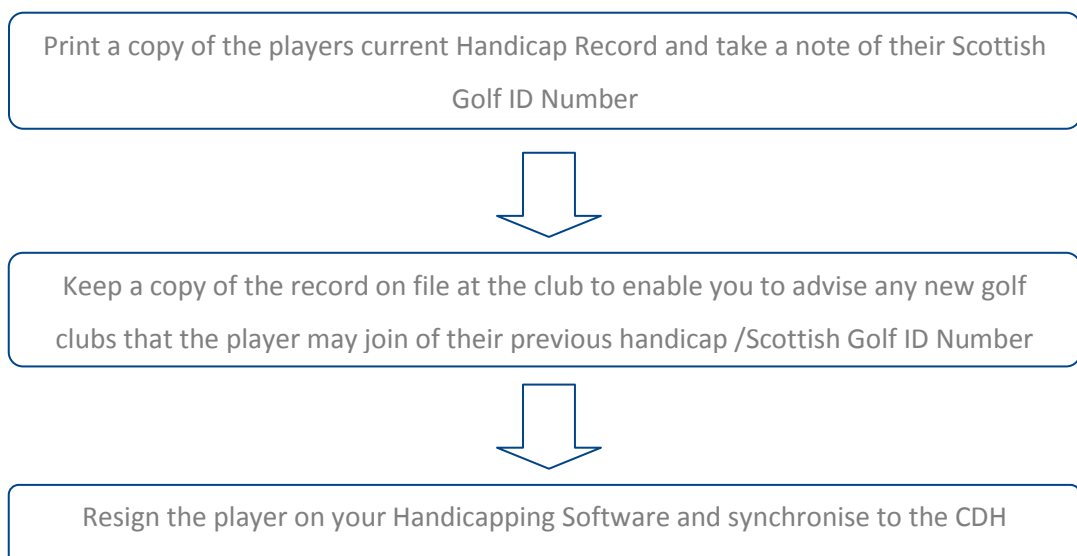


## A new member joins your club as an Away Member – what do you do?



By following the above process this will ensure players Away Scores are automatically returned to their Home Club. This should reduce future administrative workloads in processing members' away scores.
