When a player resigns from a club and joins another there is often a time interval between the two memberships. If the handicap of a player is to be restored within 12 months of the date which it was lost, it must be re-instated at the same handicap the player last held.

When restoring a Competition Handicap which has been lost for more than 12 months, the Handicap Committee must consider all the background information available to it and may allot a player an exact handicap lower/higher than that calculated by the software. After 3 cards have been returned the options available are: (CONGU Clause 26.4)

- Re-allot the player's previous handicap at the revised exact number ;*
- Re-allot the player's handicap at a different level taking account of all information on the player's previous handicap and achievements together with their current ability*
