



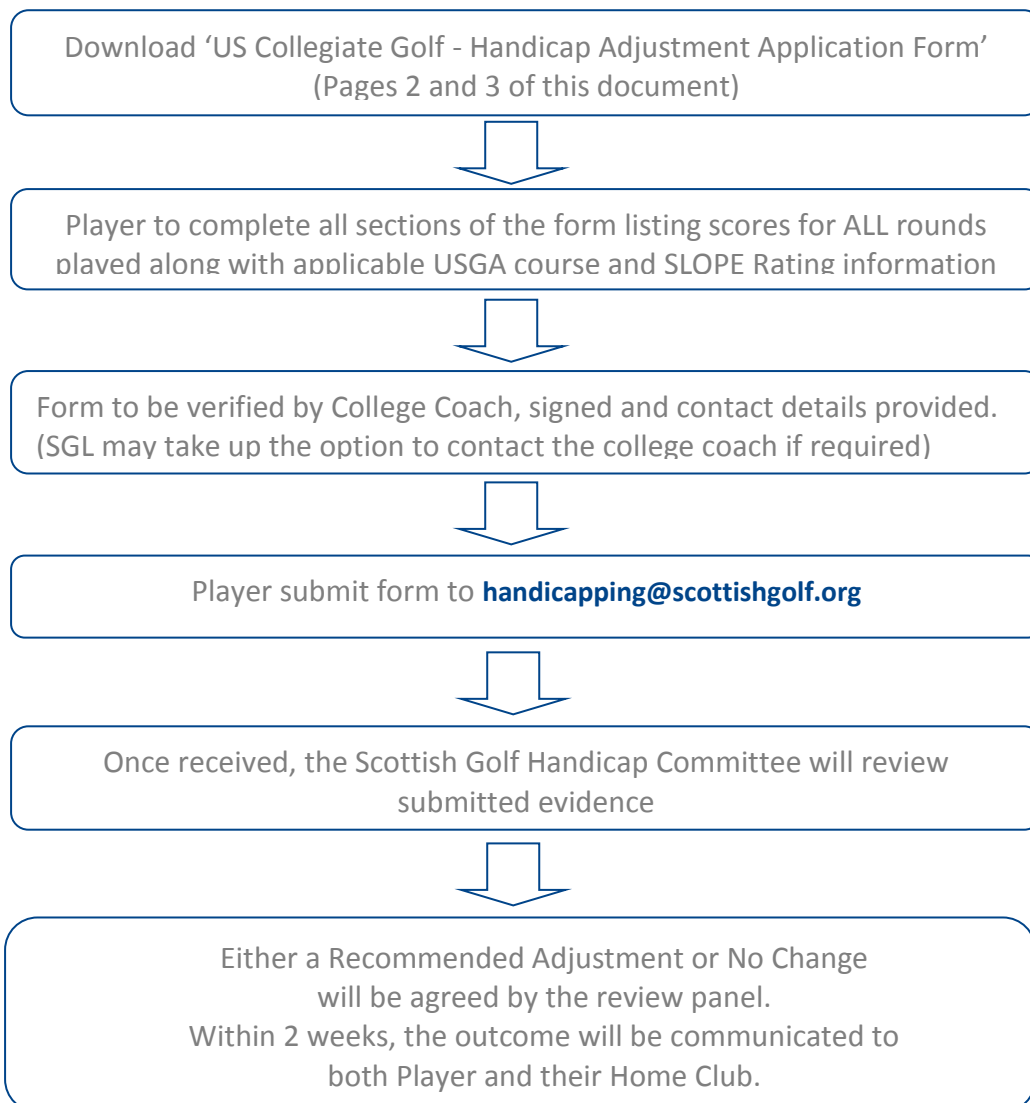
Handicap Adjustments – US Collegiate Golf

A CONGU handicap adjustment will be considered for golfers whom whilst attending a Golf Scholarship out with Scotland can provide compelling evidence to suggest their CONGU handicap no longer reflects their playing ability.

Scottish Golf will review all submitted cases and communicate the decision to both player and their Home Club.

If an adjustment is approved a General Play Adjustment should be made in accordance with the provisions of the CONGU UHS Clauses 23.2 to 23.5.
